

Risk Management Policy Statement

Rainforestation Nature Park, Kuranda is committed to ensuring the safety of staff and patrons. As such, all staff under-go training in emergency procedures as a part of their induction. Procedures are reviewed annually to take into consideration workplace changes / hazards.

Chris Grantham, General Manager is a fully qualified Workplace Health and Safety Officer and also the Workplace Representative of Rainforestation Nature Park. Regular risk assessments of the business are carried out by senior management staff under the direction of Chris Grantham.

Rainforestation Nature Park conduct regular maintenance checks of our equipment and infrastructure.

All staff partake in regular training on how to deal with an emergency situation.

In the event of an emergency, staff will;

- Evaluate the situation immediately
- Notify emergency services 000 fire, police, ambulance depending on the nature of the emergency
- · Ascertain if an evacuation is needed
- If evacuation is needed advise patrons immediately or as soon as practical of the situation and what rectification/actions will be taken
- If an evacuation is required patrons will be escorted to the assembly points
- Headcounts will be undertaken at muster points to ensure all patrons are accounted for
- Staff await further direction from emergency personnel

Key personnel of Rainforestation Nature Park are qualified First Aid Officers in the workplace.
