Alongside this, Rainforestation is also one of the largest off-site venues in Cairns and the Great Barrier Reef.

Choose from multiple unique event spaces, from a dainty rotunda in a fruit orchard, to a rustic restaurant seating up to 250 guests. Enjoy chef-prepared customisable menus featuring local produce, live music and entertainment options and more.

With access via original WW2 Army Duck to a purpose-built platform, delegates are wined and dined under the twinkling stars surrounded by pristine tropical forest.

Imagine a traditional Pamagirri welcome to country followed by bush tucker inspired delicacies.



The Courtyard is a beautiful lakeside event location featuring a sandy beach and a picturesque fountain.

After dark, this area comes to life. Enjoy cocktail parties and marquee events with the lit fountain as a beautiful backdrop.

This versatile area can cater to an array of events, including corporate and private seated or cocktail functions. The capacity for the courtyard is 300 for a standing cocktail function or 150 guests for a seated dinner.

100-250 people

Guests arrive at Rainforestation in Tropic Wings coaches and are greeted and escorted to the Koala & Wildlife Park for pre-dinner drinks, canapes and wildlife interaction. The towering gum trees are uplit. tropical ferns are lit with coloured lights while wildlife keepers roam with Koalas, Snakes and Lizards.

Then, it's off for night spotlight tours of the rainforest in original WWII Army Ducks. Our entertaining guides will take you through the rainforest pointing out plants and nocturnal animals of interest while spinning some great stories.

Guests alight the Army Ducks at the Outback Restaurant. The tropical gardens (edging three sides) are twinkling with coloured and fairy lights, tables lit with lighting indigenous inspired pieces and the band is playing, setting the perfect ambience. Guests are greeted by waiters with beverages, as they make their way to their tables, dinner is waiting.

Between courses the Pamagirri Dance Troupe takes to the stage for an enthusiastic cultural dance performance. After, kick up your heels on the dance floor as the band kicks into high gear and takes the party to a new level.



250-1200 people

This event is fun, social, casual and has the atmosphere of a carnival or festival. The whole park is lit up with festoon lights, and spotlights up into the trees. Music from multiple locations wafts through the air while roaming entertainers add to the fun. All of our usual activities run simultaneously for guests to experience and there is even star gazing late in the evening.

Upon boarding your Tropic Wings coaches guests are given a map and schedule of activities so that they can plan their evening and make sure that they experience all that is on offer.

Once at Rainforestation staff are waiting to greet your excited guests and escort them through the park to the waiting fun.

Themed food stalls are strategically placed around the park. Some of the incredible dishes on offer include BBQ burger bar with tempting Aussie sliders, noodle and curry bars dishing up boxes of delicious Asian cusine, wood fired pizzas (made to order) all followed up with locally made tropical gelato and sorbets.

Bars serving Australian beer, wine and soft drinks are also placed throughout the park for quests to enjoy.

Later in the evening, guests gravitate to our main restaurant where our party band is on stage. This is when guests really let their hair down and show off their best moves on the dance floor

Join a knowledgeable wildlife keeper for a guided tour for your group and get to know more about our residents. See endangered species, such as the Southern Cassowary, Lumholtz's Tree Kangaroo and Tasmanian Devils. Meet koalas and dingoes and marvel at our giant Estuarine Crocodile, Jack the Ripper.

If you are having an event on-site, we can even bring the wildlife to you!



Learn about indigenous culture with the Pamagirri Aboriginal Experience including the Dance Performance.

Watch a traditional dance performance in a Rainforest Amphitheatre, then join the guides for spear-throwing & didgeridoo playing demonstrations. Mesorise your guests with a Pamafirri Aboriginal Greeting on arrival, with a clapstick and didgeridoo performance around a fire pit.

The dancers can also perform during dinner in the Outback restaurant.

Also on offer is the traditional yarning circle; the traditional format for open communication, the Yarning Circle offers an introduction to Indigenous Culture from our guides and offers an open floor for questions from participants.



Looking to add something truly unique to your event? Why not explore the rainforest on an authentic World War 2 Army Duck.

Hop aboard a magnificent historical vehicle and journey through the tropical rainforest. Your guide will point out different flora and fauna.

Splash into the lake as the vehicle becomes a boat and your rainforest journey continues in water.
